Dreaming in Cuban is the first novel written by author Cristina Garcia, and was a finalist for the National Book Award. This novel moves between Cuba and the United States featuring three generations of a single hecfran-modelismo.comher: Alfred A. Knopf.

Dreaming in Cuban is “a work that possesses both the intimacy of a Chekov story and the hallucinatory magic of a novel by Gabriel Garcia Marquez” (The New York Times). Her daughter Lourdes had moved to the United States and is caompletely anti-Castro/5(47).
